Everything is high tech these days and the OCCG have joined the modern rush. We are now into the alphabet soup as a user of USGA GHIN EO. The EO represents "Electronic Option."

In essence, it means that members may now record their scores on the new Electronic Score Posting Sheet (ESPS) in the Golf Folder at the Front Desk or mail them to the

handicap chairman Jim Hammons by letter/post card.

He transmits scores to GHIN each weekend and it is possible that your latest score will precede each handicap revision by less than a week if you report your score promptly to Jim.

This means no more paper reports to GHIN, no more dependence on key punch operators to re-

cord the proper scores, and no more waiting 13 times a year for one-time mail delivery of Revised Handicap Index (RHI).

Jim Hammons spent \$2000 for the computer system and for a computer guru to help him get it operational. OCCG can best express their appreciation for Jim's action by reporting their scores to him on a timely basis. ✓
