

## **Annual Running-Jogging Championships**

The Outrigger emerged triumphant in the October Running-Jogging Championships. In the average distance run per man category, Outrigger took first by a large margin. The Outrigger had 21 participating runners who ran 2,302 miles with an average mileage per man of 104.6. The Olympic Club of San Francisco came second, with 263 runners going 22,456 miles for a total of 83.1 miles per man.

For actual number of miles run, the Los Angeles Athletic Club rolled up 30,256 miles for first place. They had 633 runners, who averaged 47.7 miles per man. New York Athletic Club had the largest number of runners, with 867. They chalked up 25,805 miles with an average per man of 29.7 miles. A Los Angeles Athletic Club runner ran a total of 716 miles in the month of the competition, an extraordinary performance for a 30-day period.
