

Golf Committee Report

Golf activity was alive and well among the OCC membership during 1976; both participation and interest were at extremely high levels. Two tournaments were held during the year, both at Olomana Golf Course. One was held in May and the other in September. A total of 88 players competed in the two tourneys, with the May outing attracting a record 52 players.

On the basis of performance in both events, Harry Robello emerged at the Club's top golfer; his scores of 86 and 76 gave him a total 162 and a comfortable lead over second place Jim Fleming with 168 (85, 83). Third ranking went to Bill Haxton at 171 (84, 87) with Roy Kesner, 174 (86, 88); Bill Capp, 176 (82, 94) and Bob Anderson, 177 (94, 83) completing the top six

At year's end, in an effort to make the OCC golf activity more responsive to the wishes of the players, your Golf Committee sent out a questionnaire to 64 golf families who had participated in one or more of the last few tournaments. The questionnaire asked the golfers to express their preferences as to location and day of week for the Club tourneys as well as their desires as to trophies.
