

August Golf Tournament another Great Success

Since Frank took over as Golf Chairman, participation in Outrigger Club tournaments has dramatically increased from some 35 participants to more than 100.

Development of rapport with the military and making arrangements for the Outrigger tournaments to be held at the military courses has been a major achievement of Walton's committee. Committee members Hal Mehlberg and Gene Long locate trophies and arrange for posters.

All committee members see that every club member is notified of every tournament and given an opportunity to play whether a single or in their own foursomes.

Those of you who have played in the tournaments are aware of the tremendous amount of work involved in putting on these events. Committee Chairman Walton is so busy that he has not had time to play himself. The liaison with the courses, checking final arrangements, making up foursomes, taking care of stragglers, handling the paper work goes on continuously while play is in progress.

The Club membership owes a huge **Mahalo** to Frank Walton and his hard working committee for having made our Club Golf tournaments major events on the Club's athletic calendar.
