Last minute no-shows and a few

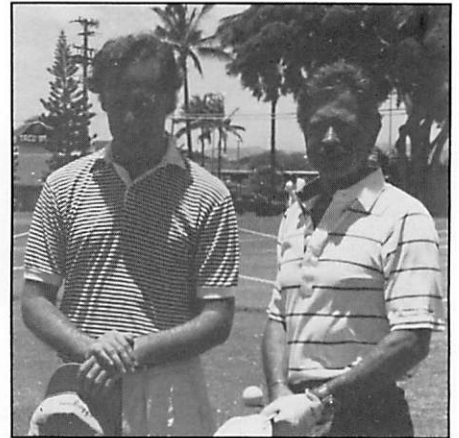
