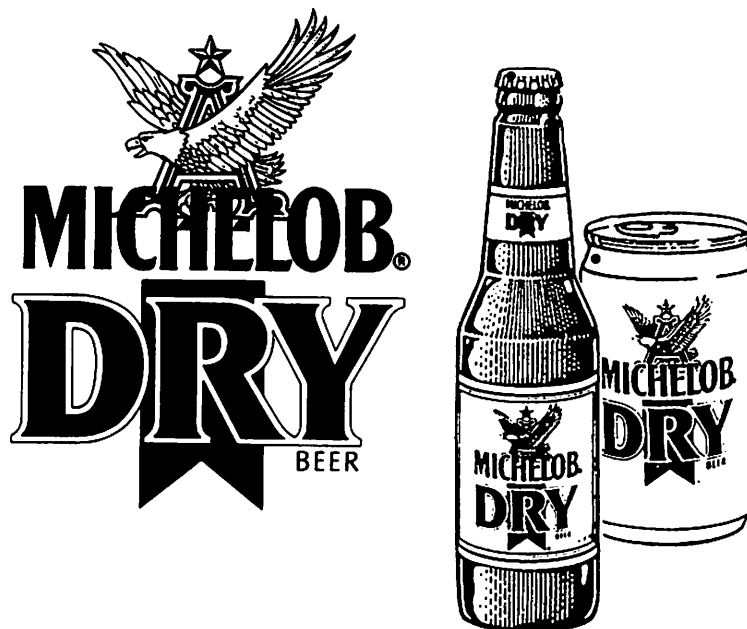
1st round: Bobbye McDermott over Cyrena Bryan on 19th hole at Leilehua.
