

Outrigger Club Booming Along

There was a meeting of the Outrigger directorate held last night in the club lanai at Waikiki. Some of the directors came in from the big surf and attended the meeting in their bathing suits.

Is there any other place in the Northern Hemisphere where this would be possible in the month of January?

Arrangements were made for raising the balance of the money needed for building the new bathhouse and today the contract was given out through Lewers & Cooke.

The new bathhouse will be fifty feet long by sixteen wide. There will be more than sixty lockers, besides a dozen private bathrooms and two showers.

The lockers will rent for a dollar a year, but a number of the club members are paying for their lockers five years in advance, that the building fund may be swelled.

The old bathhouses will be thrown into one, and turned over to the junior members for their exclusive use. The new bathhouse is for the use of the seniors.

The new 1910 membership cards are now ready and may be secured from the Hawaiian Trust Company on payment of five dollars each.

The directors decided last night, subject to approval of the members' meeting, to issue the cards to new members to run from 365 days from date of election of member.

After February 14, when the annual meeting will be held, it is proposed to charge an initiation fee to new members of \$2.50, this to be raised to \$5 for succeeding years.

There will, of course, be no initiation fee charged those who are already members or who join before February 14.

All funds and membership fees will hereafter be deposited with the Hawaiian Trust Company, and cards of membership may be paid for and received over the counter.
