It is proposed to complete much of this work in advance of the entertainment, so that those who assist may enjoy the results of their efforts. The grounds will be brilliantly illuminated on the night of the tenth of June; there will be music, dancing, McRaes and merriment everywhere, and everyone is invited to the feast and frolic—that is, everyone who has a dollar to invest.
