

OUTRIGGER CLUB READY FOR BIG CHOWDER

Plans for Entertainment Are All Arranged—McRae Company To Give Show.

Fifty-two new men members are making application today for membership in the Outrigger Club, and Tuesday the names of a score of lady members will come up at the meeting of the Women's Auxiliary. The grounds are now ready at Waikiki for the big events of June 10. The big new dancing lanai in which the chowder for one thousand guests will be served is completed; the big stage thirty-six feet wide for the McRaes is ready for the scenery which will be placed in position Friday morning when the company returns to Honolulu. There will be real footlights.

The big hau tree grove has been surrounded by cocoanut columns and a great lanai built, and now the carpenters are at work constructing frames from which the ladies will hang the lanterns that are to decorate the canoes in the Venetian carnival that opens the ball next Friday evening.

Berger's band will be there, and all of Ernest Kaal's musicians, for there will be dancing at both hotels and in the big Outrigger lanai. From 11 to 12 at night a second chowder will be served for the benefit of those who arrive too late for the dinner chowder.

The sports will begin in the afternoon, when the Clark surfing cups will be contested for by both boy and girl surfboard riders. There will be a regatta and other stunts in the surf. At night, beside the parade of illuminated canoes, there will be torchlight surfboarding and a carnival ashore on the Outrigger grounds.
