

THE PLANS OF THE OUTRIGGER CLUB

Arrangements for a Brilliant Carnival on Friday Evening.

The Outrigger Club will go in with the A. A. U. At a meeting of the directors on Saturday it was determined to go on with the work of assisting in the organization of a branch of the A. A. U. in Honolulu. Two live wires were added to the directory of the club and fifty-one new members. Curtis Hustace was elected second vice president and John Guild treasurer.

G. H. Tuttle was authorized to go ahead as acting chairman of the house committee and make a success of the big Outrigger carnival, dance and chowder next Friday at Waikiki. Lorin Andrews as acting captain will have charge of the water sports and the Venetian canoe carnival. The meeting of the directorate was followed by that of the trustees with Mr. Tuttle, and the committees in charge of the various parts in Friday's entertainment were finally adjusted. W. D. Adams will take charge of the stage attractions. The McRae company will not be here, as was expected. The committees are all in working trim now and will meet together at three-thirty Tuesday afternoon on the Outrigger grounds.

The younger members of the club are preparing both for the regatta and the illuminated surfing sports at night. Last evening young Francis Cooper and some of his companions startled guests at the Moana by coming in on the waves in the light of acetylene lamps strapped to their boards. On June 10, however, the real marine signal light sticks will be used and as these burn with a blinding glare for full five minutes when stuck in the bow of the surfboards they will present a most striking tableau of night surfing.—N-striking tableau of night surfriding.
