At five, when the rollers are usually at their best, the surfing contest will take place.

There is a Clark trophy for the best manipulator of a small surfing canoe, and another for the young men who can best handle a big canoe before the big rollers. Each youngster will be tried in three different small canoes, and in two large ones, that is if he enters for both cups.

Refreshments will be served on the grounds and at 7:30 Berger's band will show up, at 8 the performance begins in the Outrigger theatre, and at 9:30 the dances at the Moana and in the big lanai of the Outrigger club house.
