

OFFICERS ELECTED FOR OUTRIGGER CLUB

Original Ticket Was Dropped and
Other Officials Were
Put In.

The ticket with Dr. Doremus Scudder at its head was not presented, save by proxy, at the Outrigger Club's annual meeting held Saturday afternoon. There were about seventy proxies and nine voters present (a majority of all voting members) for the support of the ticket, but the proxies were ruled out, and President Dole named as a nomination committee A. G. Smith, Allan Herbert and Theodore Cooper. This committee nominated the ticket elected, which is as follows:

P. L. Weaver, president; Irwin Spalding, vice president; G. H. Tuttle, secretary; A. G. Smith, treasurer; Edmund Melanphy, captain; T. Cooper, R. B. Kietow, A. M. Nowell, directors. House committee, Allan Herbert, chairman; I. J. Canfield, T. Cooper.

But twenty voting members were present at the meeting in person.

Doctor Scudder's name was not brought up, the only objection to the nominations made by the committee being that of captain, and Edmund Melanphy was elected to this place by a vote of twelve to eight. The papers of Saturday published the list of nominations with seventy-nine behind it, as expected, not realizing perhaps that those who gave their proxies might remain away in the belief that they would be elected as directed, and that a lawyer and ten on the spot could beat the other seventy-nine, seventy of whom were present. There was no hard feeling displayed at the meeting Saturday and the ticket elected will be loyally supported by every member of the Outrigger Club.
