

CUP IS OFFERED FOR MALIHINIS

CANFIELD WOULD HAVE TROPHY FOR THOSE NEW TO SURF- BOARD GAME.

Ira Canfield, of the Outrigger Club's house committee, will offer soon a silver cup to be competed for by malihini surfboarders.

The club has the Frank Clark cups to be competed for annually by the surfboard riders and the canoe surfers of the Outrigger club, but there are one or two Kamaaina surfers who can walk away with any trophy put up, they have been surfing all their lives.

Canfield came to Honolulu a little over a year ago and at once joined the Outrigger club. He didn't miss a day in the surf for months, until at last he could stand on his board, he found other malihinis in his class. When it came to competing for any event in the surf the Malihini's didn't care to show off with the boys born in Honolulu who are brothers to the big waves, so it is that he is offering a cup to be competed for only by those who have come to Honolulu in recent years and taken up surfing.

Yesterday there were probably two hundred people in the surf. Half of these were out among the big waves at sea, and it is safe to say that half of these again were malihinis. Girls as well as men and boys were standing on their boards.

Never before has there been such activity in the sport of surfboarding. On the Outrigger grounds a dozen different boards were in all stages of construction yesterday, and there are orders out for a score of others which the youngsters will make for their elders. On the list of applicants since the last directors' meeting there are twenty-five new would-be members of the club posted, to say nothing of those ladies who are seeking admittance in the Woman's Auxiliary.

The Canfield cup will soon be on exhibition in the window of the Public Service Association, and it is probable that the affairs of the Outrigger Club will in the near future be managed from these downtown headquarters and the details of its business management taken over by the office force of the association.

Canfield is now at work trying to figure out an appropriate design on the malihini surfing cup; some of the kamaaina surfers suggest a board rising from a wave with the rider descendant.
