The club honors of the swimming meet held on Saturday afternoon in the Alakea slip were carried off by the Hui Nalu with a total of fortytwo points, the Healanis were runners-up with thirty-two points and the Myrtles managed to score five. The star performer of the day was Duke Kahanamoku, who won the 50, 100 and 220-yards events. He clipped 1 3-5 seconds off the old mark for the shorter distance and 43-5 seconds off the 100 yards record.
