

# MAY QUESTION SWIMMING RECORD

There is considerable doubt among local sportsmen as to whether the two swimming records made by Duke Kahanamoku, Jr., on August 12 will be recognized.

The performances were of such a startling nature that they are bound to be received with suspicion by the mainland authorities of the A. A. U., more especially as the hundred-yards course was found to be an inch or so

short on re-measurement.

W. R. Rawlins, an old athlete himself and one of the founders of the Hui Nalu, is going to the mainland on business in the near future and will take with him affidavits to prove the genuineness of Kahanamoku's performances. He will do all in his power to have the records recognized, and in him Hawaii will indeed have a friend in the athletic court.
