## HOLDS MEETING

### Big Entertainment to Be Held Soon—Chowder at Allan Herbert's.

There were meetings of the directors of the Outrigger Club, and of the entertainment committee, at the Public Service rooms, yesterday. President Phil. H. Weaver is coming out strong for the big entertainment, now that he is back again and in harness. Allan Herbert, chairman of the committee, gives a chowder to about twenty-five of the leading hustlers of the club under the big hau tree on the club grounds next Monday afternoon, when the plan of campaign will be finally decided on and the boosters will get busy.

Already, Trustee J. P. Cooke has subscribed for the first hundred tickets, and Wm. R. Castle for the next fifty; Irwin Spaulding and other officers of the club come close behind, and the moment that one thousand tickets have been subscribed for, the date for the entertainment will be set, and work begun on the improvements that are to be completed before the big event.

First of all the retaining wall will be built around the lagoon, the big dancing lanai will be enlarged and re-thatched, the grass house will be moved further back, thus providing a large lawn and, under the big hau tree grove, the ground will be cemented, giving a place where the male members of the club may enjoy afternoon chowder, after the swim, with the ladies.

The bathhouses of both the men and boys will be enlarged, and a hau tree lanai constructed on the beach where the algaroba grove now stands.

The entertainment will be a big affair, the club is trying to arrange for fifty singing musicians for the big dance after the chowder. In the afternoon the Clark trophies, as well as the Canfield Malhini cup will be contested for in the surf and, altogether, there will be a big day and night of it. A moonlight night will be selected—and every member of the club is requested to get together his outside friends in groups of fives and tens to take to the big event of the season, the date of which will be set just so soon as the thousand ticket are subscribed for. About three hundred have been spoken for off hand; the real subscriptions will begin at Allan Herbert's chowder on Monday afternoon.
