

OUTRIGGER FETE WILL BE GREAT

Nine Hundred Tickets Have Been
Subscribed for Already
for Affair.

More than nine hundred tickets have been subscribed for by members of the Outrigger Club for the proposed big entertainment, and not a third of the membership has yet come through, in fact, more than two-thirds of the members are yet to be given an opportunity to take tickets.

It is expected that the thousand-dollar line will be crossed today and the date set for the big show. The date most in favor is the first Saturday in November, which has a full moonlight night to end it off. After the first thousand tickets are pledged, it is the intention of the Outriggerites to immediately spend this sum on the proposed improvements that are to be completed before the entertainment; then the hustling will begin to dispose of the next five hundred tickets that are to pay the expenses of the big show; after that anything else that comes in will go to the purchase of racing and surfing canoes, and the further extension of the proposed retaining wall.

The youngsters at the Outrigger Club will take charge of the afternoon of the big day, they will form into crews and practise up for the junior races, for which a dozen different cups will be offered to juvenile winners.

The building of the retaining wall along the lagoon to the sea is required by the lease, and work will be begun on this at once. The Women's Auxiliary has offered to help most substantially toward this improvement.

The improvements on the grounds of the Outrigger Club will probably begin this week, and the hustlers will keep hustling until every member of the club has been aroused to do his duty, there are very few men who will not take at least five tickets for their friends on the day of the big fete, regatta, chowder and dance.
