

HOUSECLEANING FOR OUTRIGGER CLUB

There will be a meeting, and a spirited one, of the Outrigger Club this afternoon at the public service rooms at one o'clock. The meeting was called at the demand of a number of the members of the club who insist that the bylaws be changed so that the officers will be compelled to attend to their full duties and the members be made to come to time with all of their dues in advance without the prodding of a collector. Last summer a similar meeting was called by the members and the house committee requested to hold regular meetings and report to the directors as required by the constitution.

Several changes in the constitution will be voted on and others proposed, so that they may be posted at the club grounds and voted on at the annual election in January.

There are members of the Outrigger Club who would like to see the Sierra Club ballot adopted. This consists of a ballot on which there are twice as many names placed as are to be voted for. A ballot is mailed to each member and he marks the names of the men he wishes to vote for, or he may write out a new list. The meeting today is a most important one in every way for each and every member of the club in view of the fact that the annual election is held next month.
