

MANY IMPROVEMENTS FOR OUTRIGGER CLUB

It was an enthusiastic meeting of the Outrigger Club at the public service rooms yesterday afternoon. The proposed amendments to the constitution were all adopted unanimously, so that hereafter any member who permits himself to fall in arrears in the payment of his dues will be posted and dropped from the club.

The treasurer reported that the new retaining wall and the filling in at the club grounds had been paid for and there still remained a surplus from the recent entertainment of over four hundred dollars, with more to come. This balance is to be used in rethatching the big lanai and the grass houses as well as providing a place where the men of the club may entertain their wives and friends of the family. The directors were requested to see that proper sign boards were placed at the club with the names thereon of the officers of the Outrigger Club and of the ladies' auxiliary.

The treasurer reported that \$300 had been appropriated months ago for the completion of the men's bath house, and that while \$180 had been paid there was still a bill outstanding of \$220. The addition was not built in accord with the instructions of the directors or the wish of the members. The meeting yesterday unanimously requested the directors to see to it that the house committee completed the bath house as contemplated, so that there will be fifty more lockers for the juniors and as many more for the seniors. It was also decided to take steps to clear the club property of houses and fences abutting on the club grounds. In this President Weaver stated that he had the assurance of cooperation from the Bishop Estate. Altogether it was the most progressive meeting yet held of the Outrigger members, and it looks now as though there is to be a lively campaign of events at Waikiki.
