

# OUTRIGGER CLUB BEGINS IMPROVEMENT CAMPAIGN; MANY SPORTS PLANNED

The Outrigger directorate had the most lively and businesslike session yesterday afternoon at the Outrigger grounds, ever held by the organization. Incidentally about a thousand dollars were appropriated for improvements, some of which have been dragging on for a year or more, but will now be completed off hand.

President Tuttle, the new head of the club, announced that the promotion committee had appropriated fifty dollars to assist in the entertainment of the Cleveland tourists, the Public Service Association twenty-five, and that The Hands-Around-the-Pacific and the Civic Federation would also join in to make the entertainment of the visitors complete.

Mr. Tuttle is also president of the A. A. U., and as a uniter of all factions to boost for Hawaii is the man of the hour. The club appropriated funds to improve the beach at Waikiki; sufficient to rethatch the big lanai and the grass houses, enough to move the two native grass houses to a better location, ordered the new bathhouse built for the juniors, an addition to

the men's bathhouse and a new house for the surf boards. In addition to this appropriations were made to cover the expense of putting a float in the Floral Parade and sending canoes down to take part in the illuminated water carnival. For this latter two cups will be given by the club to the youngster, boy or girl who will put the best decorated canoe in the carnival. The club will provide the canoes and have them at Alakea wharf ready to be decorated.

The Outrigger Club having become an integral part of the Public Service Association, Guy H. Tuttle and J. R. Galt were elected as directors of that organization to represent the Outrigger Club. Hereafter the secretary's office will be at the Public Service rooms and the actual business of the Outrigger Club conducted there.

The finances of the Outrigger Club are now in good condition and new members are applying daily. Dr. Doremus Scudder and Secretary C. F. Maxwell have taken hold with a vim and together with the president are planning for the liveliest campaign of sports and entertainments the club has ever known.
