NEW BATH HOUSE AT OUTRIGGER CLUB

The Outrigger Club will begin work at once on the new bath house at Waikiki for the wives, daughters and mothers of the men and boy members.

This was the decision of the directors at a meeting in the Public Service

rooms yesterday.

The contract will be let on Monday and a new bath house with twenty bath rooms near the lagoon will be used as a continuation of the present

bath house of the woman's auxiliary. With the completion of the new bath house, the fifty wives, mothers and sisters of clab members, who have subscribed for the erection of the new bath house, will become members of the woman's auxiliary, giving this organization a membership of two hun-

dred and fifty women, the men's club having a few over three hundred on its roll. This makes the Oftrigger by far the largest club in the Territory. Until the new bath house is completed the lady members will have only the privileges of the general lanai and restaurant which is on the men's

grounds. But after the completion of their bath house they will graduate into the auxiliary with full privileges. The settlement of the woman's bath house was not the only business, accomplished at the directors' meeting. They decided to enter into a contract with the Hawaiian Electric Company to lay complete underground wires, so that when an occasion demands it the Outrigger grounds may be effectively

illuminated.

The financial condition of the club is in excellent shape, and with nearly seven hundred members the club is considering the question of limiting all classes of membership to a thousand or twelve hundred, as the available space for new bath houses is rapidly

diminishing.
