

# MANY HONOLULU CLUBS TO HAVE FLOATS BUILT FOR CARNIVAL PARADE

Everybody seems to have caught the spirit of the Pan-Pacific Carnival which will be held next February and already over a 100 floats have been promised for the parade opening day.

The latest to fall into line is practically every club in the city and many private citizens have also contributed. The Outrigger Club will have a \$200 float showing Father Neptune holding in leash 20 monster Hawaiian fish. Other organizations which will have interesting floats are the Trail and Mountain Club, A. A. U., Automobile Club, University Club and Y. M. C. A., California, Southern, Ad Club and Boy Scouts. Australia will have seven floats representing each of its commonwealths, and New Zealand, three. The Filipinos have already sent home for material for their float and the Koreans and Chinese are building theirs. The Japanese section is expected to create a sensation as their 12 floats will represent each months of the year.
