WOMEN ARE GIVEN OUTRIGGER RIGHTS

Club Votes, 234 To 8 To Extend Privileges To Feminine Friends of Its Members

By a vote of 234 to eight the Outrigger Canoe Club, at its meeting held last night, carried the resolution extending to women friends of members the privileges of the club. There were present 104 members in person and 141 by proxy, a total of 245. The resolution reads as follows:

"Be it resolved by the members of

the Outrigger Canoe Club, in special meeting assembled this fourteenth day of November, that the board of directors be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to provide dressing room facilities, on any ground controlled by the club, for the accommodation of female guests of members; and, be it further

"Resolved, that said board of directors be and it is hereby authorized to make such charges, rules and regulations as it may deem proper and necessary for the use and government of said dressing room facilities."

The amendment providing for voting by mail was defeated by a vote of 224 to eighteen. Amendments to Sections four, fifty-two and seventy-four were adopted by a vote of 227 to thirteen.
