

**P**ERRY McGILLIVRAY, whose picture is shown below, will arrive in the Wilhelmina next Tuesday morning from San Francisco with Miss Dorothy Burns and Mrs. Aileen Allen, all of whom will take part in the coming Carnival Swimming Meet, February 22-24. McGillivray, who is a member of the Illinois Athletic Club of Chicago, is the man who defeated Duke Kahanamoku on April 8, 1916, at Pittsburgh, in the 100-yard distance, when the victor made the sprint in 56 3-5 seconds now the world's record. Since Kahanamoku has announced that he will not swim in the coming meet he has tacitly acknowledged that he will allow McGillivray to remain his master for the distance.
