

CONCRETE BEACH WALK PLAN IS READY TO GO BEFORE LEGISLATURE

As soon as the plans and specifications for the proposed Waikiki concrete beach walk are checked up and printed a bill will be drawn to introduce into the legislature for the appropriation of \$120,000 for the work. This appropriation also includes the dredging out of three bathing places, in front of the public baths, Moana and Seaside hotels and Outrigger club and the property between Lewers road and Fort De Russy.

The survey has been completed, according to Charles R. Forbes, chairman of public works, and the bill will be introduced as soon as possible. Who is to introduce the bill has not been decided upon. It is planned to have the \$120,000 come out of the loan fund.
