# DUDE MILLER TO BE ADMIRAL OF WELCOME FLEET

Dude Miller, one of the best known devotees of aquatics in Hawaii, has been named as admiral of the Outrigger canoe fleet which will welcome the Matson liner Maui on her maiden trip to Honolulu next month.

Miller will have charge of the fleet which will be made up of outrigger canoes from the Hui Nulu and Outrigger clubs. Inasmuch as Miller is a descendant of the earliest navigators of the Pacific and Capt. Peter Johnson is a descendant of the Vikings, the earliest navigators in the Atlantic, the meeting of the two commanders should be unique in the history of navigation.

The first sea-going boat in Hawaii will meet the latest type of liner in the harbor when the Maui arrives. It is expected that 20 or more canoes will be in the fleet with a number of Hawaiian musicians and passengers.
