

FAVORABLE SITE FOR BOAT CLUBS URGED

Representatives of various civic, social and business organizations of the city gave their views to the harbor board favoring a suitable boat club site at the hearing this afternoon. Among those who spoke were Capt. George T. Perkins of Fort Armstrong, Ed Towse, Rotary Club; Raymond C. Brown, Chamber of Commerce; Guy Buttolph, Outrigger Club; Alexander Hume Ford, Pan-Pacific Club; A. E. Larimer, Y. M. C. A.; and D. E. Kroll of the Hawaiian Rowing Association. Letters expressing all possible cooperation with the boat club plans were read from Allen & Robinson and Lewers & Cooke, lumber merchants.

Members of the board expressed themselves as favorable to a proper site, but raised the question as to whether an appropriation for swimming purposes would be legal. Senator Chillingworth urged the clubs to borrow the money extending hope that the legislature would reimburse them at its next session.
