

OUTRIGGER CLUB ELECTION STIRS NEW CANDIDATES

Competing with the "Harmony Ticket," a letter was received Tuesday night by the board of directors, Outrigger Canoe club, placing in nomination the names of J. Ashman Beaven, present secretary of the club, for president, and Chas. E. King, for chairman of the order and entertainment committee.

The directors also received the report of the nominating committee. With the entrance into the campaign of the Beaven-King ticket the full list of nominees now reads as follows:

The letter naming Beaven and King was signed by a number of Outrigger members, and means that there are now three candidates each in the field for the positions of president and entertainment committee chairman. The campaign is now the chief topic of talk among Outrigger members at the beach, in their homes, and downtown.

Notices of the annual meeting will be placed in the mail tomorrow by Secretary Beaven. The meeting will be held at 8 p. m. next Tuesday night, July 24, in the lecture hall of the Library of Hawaii building. Every member is urged to be present and the election will undoubtedly be the closest in years.

No members whose dues for the current fiscal year have not been paid will be allowed to vote at the meeting.

Members will have the right to nominate anyone else for any office at the meeting, if they do not like the names nominated by the nominating committee and those members who are working for Beaven and King.
