

"HARMONY" TICKET WINS EASY VICTORY IN OUTRIGGER CLUB

Hottest Election Organization
Has Known Results In De-
feat of Opposition

**H. B. CAMPBELL AGAIN
CHOSEN AS PRESIDENT**

Four Directors On Whom There
Were Contests Run Far Ahead
When Ballots Are Counted

H. B. Campbell was elected president of the Outrigger Club to succeed himself last night, overwhelmingly defeating J. Ashman Beaven, and thus triumphed Alexander Hume Ford and the "Harmony" ticket in the hottest election the club has experienced in its existence.

There were four contests on the ticket and the "Harmony" party took them all in camp by big leads. Campbell got 226 votes to Beaven's 90; H. B. Podmore, for chairman of the order and entertainment committee got 225 votes to Charles King's 84; Herman von Holt for director got 213 against F. G. W. Cooper's 114, and J. M. Westgate, also director, got 194 against A. J. Porter's 93.

G. H. Buttolph was reelected vice-president without contest, Percy Deverill, secretary, L. C. Thompson for treasurer, and Dr. F. C. Mighton as chairman of the house committee—all without contest.

Members Gather Early

The election was held in the upper floor of the Library of Hawaii. Quite early in the evening men, from the old member to the youngest, gathered on the broad lanai of the library and talked like seasoned politicians on the outcome of the event.

Then they filed up stairs and lined up for the ballots. The line was long and kept growing until after nine o'clock. Fully 200 members of the club were present, the great majority of them holding proxies, which had been sedulously acquired during the campaign, most of which were voted by the self-styled "Harmony" ticket headed by Mr. Campbell for president, G. H. Buttolph for vice-president, P. H. Deverill for secretary, L. C. Thompson for treasurer, G. D. Center for captain, F. C. Mighton for chairman of the clubhouse committee, Harold B. Podmore for chairman of the order and entertainment committee, and Herman von Holt and J. M. Westgate for directors.

Many Proxies Voted

More interest was worked up in this election than has ever been known in the Outrigger Club. Members who could not be present were represented by proxies secured by Ford and his followers. Early in the evening backers of the "Harmony" ticket predicted a clean sweep on the strength of their proxies alone.
