

OUTRIGGER CLUB TO HAVE FLOATS NEAR THE SHORE

Due in a large measure to the enthusiastic efforts of Walter Duisenberg, the Outrigger Club will shortly install one or more floats between the beach and the present diving stage opposite the club grounds, and possibly another float out in the deep water beyond the diving stage for use in life-saving emergencies and as a resting place for the club's stronger swimmers.

During the past two or three days Mr. Duisenberg has raised \$176 toward the expense of installing these floats.

The subscription list is now in the hands of Treasurer Thompson.

The following letter, authorizing Mr. Duisenberg to go ahead with the work of raising the funds for the float, was sent by the board of directors of the club on August 2:

"The diving platform at the beach is so far away from the shore that our weaker swimmers, including the women and children, seldom, if ever, go out to it. Two or more floats nearer in, which could be used for resting and diving places, would be most welcome. Also, there is a demand for a float out in the deep water for our stronger swimmers, and for life saving emergencies.

"The board of directors of the Outrigger Canoe Club is heartily in sympathy with this movement, and will undertake to see that any money subscribed for the purpose is expended effectively. The board appreciates your offer to head a subscription list to raise funds for these floats and hereby authorizes you to solicit subscriptions to such a list."
