

# LIFE GUARD NOW PATROLS CLUB BEACH

**T**O care especially for the women and children who swim at the beach at Waikiki, David Kahanamoku, brother of Duke Kanahamoku, the world's champion swimmer, and a swimmer of note himself, has been employed as a life guard by the directors of the Outrigger club. Kahanamoku is now on the beach all day wearing a suit bearing the lettering "O. C. C. Life Guard."

Agitation for a life guard at the beach has been made several times following the drowning of persons on the beach and the presence of men whose treatment of the women there was not what it should be. When the board of supervisors failed to respond, the Outrigger club appointed their own life guard.

Members of the Outrigger club who wish to go in swimming and have no place to take their children can leave them under the care of Kahanamoku. He will also watch to see that no undesirable characters menace the women of the club. Just yesterday he removed a man under the influence of liquor from the beach. He has been given a police badge with the accompanying powers.

That a permanent canoe be placed in the water where the people swim in order that swimmers may have some place to drop pieces of coral which they are constantly picking out of the water, is a suggestion that will probably be acted upon by the club. Since the movement to remove the coral from the beach was started, swimmers have taken to picking up pieces of coral they step on.
