The above list of performances include not only the world's record officially recognized by the A. U. and International Federation, but the best performances made in various events. American records are recognized by the A. U. for tanks not less than 29 yards in length for the following events: 50, 100, 120, 150, 200, 202, 300, 440 and 509 yards; 100 and 150 yard backstroke; 100 and 200 yard breast stroke. The 880, 1000 and mile event are recognized if made over a course not less than 220 feet long. Federation conditions call for a tank not less than 25 yards long. Other events are listed as noteworthy performances. These have been gathered from various sources, and as near as possible follow the record books on awimming. It is expected that some of these records will be changed before the big meet in Honolulu harbor is over.
