

OUTRIGGER CLUB HAS NEW WATER EQUIPMENT

Two horses are among the new pieces of swimming equipment which the outrigger club is placing in the water in front of its establishment at Waikiki. Another raft has been anchored inside of the diving stand and over towards the Moana pier. Still another raft will later be placed farther out.

Besides the diving pier there are now two rafts at Waikiki. The one farthest out has a spring board and the latest to be put in has a diving stand and a trapeze, until it was sawed off after the first day. The third raft is being built.

The horses are no more than two heavy barrels appropriately painted and weighted down with lead in order that the heads arranged on them will always remain upright. The trick is to try to ride them and up to date David Kahanamoku, the Outrigger guard, has been the only person to stay on them any length of time.
