Saturday's Events To Consist of Swimming Races and Surf-board Numbers

The second act on the Outrigger Canoe Club regatta program will be staged the coming Saturday afternoon on and off the beach at Waikiki and it promises to be even a greater success than was last Saturday's.

There is no charge for admission and all are welcome to a comfortable seat on the beach sand. As in the events already staged, gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to those making place in Saturday's races.

The program for Saturday afternoon will be as follows:

Two hundred and twenty-yard swim for men, novice.

Fifty-yard swim for ladies, novice.

Fifty-yard swim for boys under fifteen.

Fifty-yard swim for men.

Fifty-yard backstroke swim for ladies.

Hundred-yard breaststroke swim for boys under fifteen.

Hundred-yard backstroke swim for men.

Malihini Surfboarding

Paddling on surfboard, for malihini users, from Seaside Hotel to Moana Hotel pier.

Similar number, for girls under sixteen, same distance.

Two hundred and twenty-yard swim for men.

A week from next Sunday will be canoe and surfboard race day. The program will be as follows:

Canoe surfing, for seniors, six men, for Frank Clark cup; from Outrigger Canoe Club around stake off canoe surf to beach on Diamond Head side of pier.

Canoe surfing, for juniors, three boys under sixteen, for Frank Clark cup; same course.

Surfboard Riding Events

Surfboard riding, for juniors, girls under sixteen, for unnamed cup; canoe surf.

Similar number, for malihinis, for I. D. Canfield cup; same course.

Similar number, for senior ladies, for Frank Clark cup; Queen's Surf course.

Body surfing, for gold, silver and bronze medals; Queen's Surf.

Surfboard riding, juniors, for boys under sixteen, for unnamed cup; Queen's Surf course.

Similar number, for seniors, men, for Frank Clark cup; same course.

Saturday afternoon, November 24, will be devoted entirely to swimming, and the final day of the regatta, Saturday, December 1, to swimming, canoe and surfboard events.

The Outrigger Canoe Club's first annual regatta will come to a close with the big chowder and dance to be held at the pavilion of the organization on Saturday evening, December 1.
