

RAWLINS SELECTED SWIM MEET HEAD

Carnival Committee Decides To Use Y. M. C. A. Pool For Events

Thursday, February 21, and Saturday, February 23, have been decided upon tentatively as the dates for the coming Carnival A. A. U. swimming meet, which will be held in the Y. M. C. A. pool. War-time conditions have prevented the staging of the meet in the harbor and the use of the Outrigger Canoe Club beach and Fort De Russy pool for the purpose has been found impracticable.

The Carnival committee, through George H. Angus, the chairman announced yesterday that Will T. Rawlins will have full charge of the plans for the meet. Mr. Rawlins will be assisted by John F. Soper, chairman of the registration committee of the local A. A. U., and other officials of the organization.

The Hui Nalu, Healani, Outrigger, Palama, Y. W. C. A. and other swimming clubs are already putting their mermen and mermaids through the paces for the coming meet and the competition will probably be greater than Honolulu has ever witnessed before.

About and around the "Y" pool there is seating capacity for at least a thousand spectators. A. E. Larimer, executive secretary of the "Y", is cooperating with the meet officials.
