

Track Classic Promises To Enthuse Spectators

List of Entries for Tomorrow's Big Meet Augurs Well for Its Success—25th, Waikiki, Outrigger and Honolulu Athletic Club Ruling Favorites—Amazing Array of Track and Field Talent—Lieut. Nye Will Start

All is in readiness for the biggest track and field meet ever staged in the Hawaiian Islands. Tomorrow afternoon at 1:30 p. m. upwards of 250 athletes will gather at Kapiolani park and endeavor for the remainder of the day to prove their cinder capabilities. The officials have been selected, the course lined up, the tracksters groomed for the fray and the crowd is all set for an afternoon of rare enjoyment.

The various teams are loud in their claims of track ability and several have already laid claim to first honors. Of course some of them will be disappointed, but some team will win, that is certain. Will it be the 25th? Major Carr says "No." Will it be the Waikiki? Some say "Most assuredly." Others are vehement in their praise of this or that organization.

Antarctic sea-leopard, Weddell seal, and penguin oil may one day have a place in world commerce. Samples of these oils sent to the Imperial Institute in London by Sir Douglas Mawson for the Australasian Antarctic Expedition have been pronounced of good quality and capable of being utilized for the purposes to which
