

TEN TEAMS FILE ENTRIES; MEET THURSDAY NIGHT

Ten teams so far have filed entry into the Oahu Service Basketball League. The closing hour for entries has been extended owing to the fact that the 1st Hawaiian Infantry team entry is uncertain. While their entry has been made, there is a probability that the regiment may be demobilized before the season is completed. Hence, Capt. William Miles is endeavoring to locate a sufficient number of players in the team who would reside in the city upon demobilization to finish the schedule. The uncertainty of this entry had necessitated leaving the entry lists open until the meeting on Thursday night.
