

# Oahu-Service Athletic League Secures National Guard Armory For Seven-Week Season

A deal was closed yesterday by J. Ashman Beaven, president-manager of the Oahu-Service Athletic League, whereby the league will have the use of the National Guard of Hawaii armory Sunday afternoons and Thursday evenings for the regular basketball matches of the circuit.

The league opens its seven-week season next Sunday afternoon, the initial match to begin at 2:30 o'clock, and the second to be played right following the completion of the first. Then, the coming Thursday evening, beginning 7:30 o'clock, there will be another double-header. This will be the procedure to be followed during the series of 28 matches.

As stated in The Advertiser last Sunday morning, Dr. A. E. Nichols has withdrawn his navy team from the league, combining it with the Fort Kamehameha team under the management of Lieut. A. B. Wells. This leaves eight teams, instead of nine as originally entered, in the league, allowing all of them to play in the same double-header.

The schedule for next Sunday afternoon and the following Thursday evening is as follows, the remainder of the calendar to be announced later:

Sunday, 2:30 p. m.—Outrigger vs. Fort Kamehameha; Marines vs. Wireless.

Thursday, 7:30 p. m.—College of Hawaii vs. Department Hospital; Signal Corps vs. First Hawaiian Infantry.
