

# PREXY BEAVEN ANNOUNCES CARD FOR BASKETBALL

President J. Ashman Beaven of the Oahu Service Athletic League this morning announced the schedule for the basketball league, which opens its series on Sunday next. A deal was closed yesterday whereby the Oahu Service Basketball League will have the use of the armory Sunday afternoon and Thursday evenings.

It will be a short season this year. Due to the fact that the baseball season is already approaching, the basketball season has been cut to seven weeks. Nevertheless, the basketball fans may expect some excellent sport during the seven weeks.

## Gives

The schedule, as announced this morning, gives the Outrigger Club three Sunday and four weekday games. It gives the Kam-Navy outfit five Sunday and two week-day games, and the Marines get four Sunday and three week-day sets. The Wireless team gets the same as the Marines while the College of Hawaii plays its entire seven games on week days. The Hospital, Signal Corps and 1st Hawaiian each have four Sunday games and three week day games.

The entire schedule is played on Sunday afternoon and Thursday evenings with the exception of the week ending on Washington's birthday, when the doubleheader is played on Monday, February 17, and the next session held on Thursday, February 27.

Sunday games will start at 2:30 o'clock and week day games will start at 7:30 o'clock.
