

NO INDOOR GAMES UNTIL MARCH

No indoor games of basketball will be played by the Oahu Service League teams until the month of March and even then the teams will have to vote on the question before action is taken.

There has been some demand to play indoors but on the whole the outdoor court at Moiliili has proved fairly satisfactory. And though the influenza regulation will be lifted on Monday it will be two weeks before the armory can be secured for games as the Shriners' Happyland will be held there.

While there was a possibility of a game on Thursday, February 27, it has been learned that the cleaning up of the armory will not be completed before that date and hence it will be March 6 before an indoor game can be played.

The card for tomorrow at Moiliili will bring out the 1st Hawaiian Infantry in the first game against the College of Hawaii. The second game should be a crackerjack with the Coast Defense meeting the Marines. Sunday there will be an exhibition game between a team to be picked and the Signal Corps and the second game will see the Department Hospital and Outrigger Club in action.
