

COLLEGIANS CONQUER SURF RIDERS

FORWARD PASSES FEATURE BATTLE

Featured by dazzling forward passes which netted a total of over 156 yards for both teams, the College of Hawaii-Outrigger football match at Moillili field Saturday was won by the Green men scoring four touchdowns to the loser's one. Captain "Dusky" Brash made three of the touchdowns while Johnny Thompson came in with one. The Outrigger score was made by Chris Willis.

The canoemen were the first to score in the first quarter when Willis caught a forward pass on the college 20-yard line and ran to the goal post. Canario kicked goal. After this they were unable to score another point although at several stages of the game they advanced the ball to the Green's two and five yard lines. The Green played great football and the machine trained by Prof. D. L. Crawford showed lots of football science.

Come Back

The first college touchdown was negotiated in four minutes of play. A series of plunges and line bucks gave the college the ball on the Outrigger's four yard line. With three unsuccessful attempts to smash the line Captain Brash took the oval on the fourth play and tore through left tackle over the scoring line. The second one was also made in this period when the visitors fumbled on their 20-yard line with Peter Hanohano falling on the ball. Then it was given a march down the opponent's posts and the ball was again given to Brash for the touch-

down. A long forward pass, Harvey to Thompson, gave the Greens the third touchdown when the daring college end darted down a broken field for 40 yards. The last score was made by Brash, who grabbed another pass of 16 yards hurled by Harvey at the Outrigger's 22-yard line. Three goals were kicked by Harvey. He missed one by a narrow margin.

On the college bunch Brash again proved too much for the Outrigger. Johnny Thompson, Bromley, Hanohano and Harvey played in great shape. Canario was the only man on the losing team to show anything and in the latter part of the game Joe Stickney surprised the fans by his fast running with the ball. George McInerny played a hard game at center.
