

GRID BATTLE AT MOILIILI WILL RIVAL KING TURKEY

**Town Team and Outrigger
Elevens Meet Today In An-
nual Xmas Contest**

**INMAN GETS SCHOLASTIC
STARS TO HELP LINE-UP**

**Schumanites Crippled By Loss of
Stars But Likely To Spring
Surprise**

SPORT fans who like to mix football and turkey will have a good chance to do so today simply by traveling out to Moiliili Field before or after turkey time, depending upon their respective dinner hours, where the football elevens of the Outrigger Canoe Club and the Town Team will battle in their annual Christmas Day game. The struggle is scheduled to start promptly at 3 p. m.

The two elevens have clashed once before this season, the Outriggers getting the short end of a 13 to 0 score. However the dope based on that game will not go today. The Outriggers have made a number of notable additions to their line-up which should strengthen it materially, while rumor has it that the Schumanites are handicapped by the loss of several star players.

Bill Inman has obtained the services of W. Thompson, the fleet College of Hawaii end, Spencer, who creditably filled the fullback position for the Collegians while Bromley was out of the game, Searle, the crackerjack quarter from Punahou and Hoopii, one of the star halfbacks of the same institution.

"Scotty" Schuman is keeping mum about his prospects, but it isn't safe to take his silence as lack of confidence. The Town Team captain doesn't tell all he knows and is likely to spring some surprises tomorrow. His team will be handicapped by the loss of Piper Rodrigues and Andrews, the two star ends, both of whom will be out of the game because of injuries. Rosa, who has played at quarter all season, will take Piper's place at left end, and Schuman himself will run the team from the quarter position.

To accommodate the large crowd expected, J. Ashman Beaven, lessee of Moiliili Field, has had the left field bleachers moved over to the ewa side of the field, giving the bleachers there a seating capacity of more than 1400, in addition to the 1500 seats in the grandstand. The Waikiki and Kaimuki sides of the field will be reserved for automobiles as heretofore. Automobile space may be reserved by telephoning 4748 until noon today.
