

# INMAN-SCHUMAN GRID WARRIORS MAY PLAY AGAIN

## Fans Calling For Game On New Year's Day To Decide Question of Supremacy

Followers of the Outrigger and Town Team football elevens are calling loudly for a game on New Year's day to decide the question of which is the better gridiron aggregation, and it is probable that the game will be played. Being practically the only sporting attraction in Honolulu on that day, a large crowd can be expected, especially in view of the large following each team has attracted.

By winning the game Christmas afternoon by a score of 9 to 7, the Outrigger eleven placed itself on an equal footing with the Schumanites who defeated it in the first meeting of the two teams this season by 13 to 0.

As it developed, Searle's field goal from the 30-yard line was the bit of play that brought victory to the Beachcombers Thursday. It came in the last few moments of the first period, the pigskin sailing squarely between the goal posts. For a moment in the last quarter with the score Outrigger 9, Town Team 7, it looked as if victory would perch on the Town Team roost when Piper Rodrigues tried for a field goal from the 48-yard line, the ball falling less than a yard short of the crossbar. Had Rodrigues been allowed to kick a few moments before from the 30-yard line, he undoubtedly would have scored.

The Schumanites owe their scoring to "Buck" Aarona, the befty fullback, who tore great holes in the opposing line in the third quarter, ending his efforts with a plunge which took him over the goal line for the only Schuman touchdown. Rodrigues kicked the goal, making the Town Team's total of points seven.

In the second quarter, the Outriggers got the most out of a costly fumble by the Town Team when Stickney, who had just been sent in, grabbed the ball as an over-anxious Town Team player dropped it and ran 60 yards for a touchdown. Searle failed to kick goal, but the Beachcombers were nine points to the good nevertheless.

A number of times the Town Team got within a few yards of its goal but were unable to push the pigskin across.
