

OUTRIGGERS BEAT BRAVES IN FIRST A.A.U. BASKETBALL

Score Is 38 To 16—Palama De-
feats All-Chinese Team
By 36 To 20

The A. A. U. championship basket-
ball series opened at the Y. M. C. A.
last night with a doubleheader between
the All-Chinese and the Palamas in
the 135-pound division and the Braves
against the Outrigger in the unlimited
class.

A large attendance filled the gallery
and the spectators were treated to
fast, clean basketball. This is the
first of a series of athletics which will
be handled by the A. A. U.

The first match was opened with a
score for Palama in the first quarter
by Lee Choy. This was the first of
the 36 points which the Palamas made
against the All-Chinese 20 points. Both
teams showed lack of practice and
many fouls were called by the referee
who kept the game well in hand. Lee
Chong playing at forward was kept
busy making points and scored 26 out
of the 36 made in the game. The
other members of the winning team
supported their forwards and displayed
good headwork.

The All-Chinese were outpointed by
16 points in the total score, making 20
points altogether. Eight baskets were
shot from the field and only four out
of a possible eleven points scored. They
put up a good fight and showed that
they will be able to play the game
when they have the get-together idea
in their play.

The final match between the un-
limited teams resulted in a score of
38 for the Outriggers, to the Braves'
16. This was a fast match and both
teams played well. Outrigger scored
22 points in the first half and fol-
lowed with 16 in the second. Fred
Biven was to be a real basketshooter
and scored 19 points for his team. Ca-
nario stayed with Biven for seven
points and Nottage for 4 while Camp-
bell came across with 6. This team
has a good chance for the champion-
ship with the combination of Gilbert
Canario and Bivens.

The Braves made their maiden at-
tempt at the basket game and they
showed they could play other games
beside baseball. While they have not
been playing the basket game long
they had a good line-up and showed
up well against the stronger team. C.
Lewis seemed to be their star basket
man and was backed by Smith, Anahu
and August.
