Small Tidal Wave Topples Outrigger's Big Clock At Beach

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Bathers at the Outrigger and Moana beaches will have to carry their own watches or guess at the time for a few days instead of having the big Outrigger clock to rely upon.

The Anuakehau stream became ambitious Friday evening and tried to imitate the Gulf tidal waves that sweep over the Galveston wall. The best it could do was to cut out the sand until it had undermined the concrete foundation of the big timepiece at the eastern end of the Outrigger dancing pavilion causing the clock to fall over against the pavilion pillars so that it was almost wrenched from its post. No other damage was done, although the stream was almost up to the level of the Moana wall.

For some time the stream has been threatening to cut under the foundations of the clock and the pavilion and it is probable that the club will be forced to build a protecting wall along one side of the stream.
