

OUTRIGGER CLUB TO HAVE PUNAHOU STARS

Although Punahou is not to be represented as a school in the coming Centennial track meet, five of her best men are to perform under the auspices of the Outrigger Canoe club. They will be Douglas Crozier, Chris Willis, Sam Poepoe, Robert Mott-Smith and Mortimer Lydgate.

Douglas Crozier, who was this year captain of the champion Punahou track team, will enter the 880, which is his favorite race. Crozier broke the Interscholastic record at the meet held on March 20.

Poepoe and Willis will run on the Outrigger half-mile relay team. Chris Willis is to be track captain next season at Punahou. He took first in the hundred yard dash at the Cornell meet and second in the same race in the Interscholastic. Poepoe, who will graduate from Punahou this year, placed fourth in the hundred at the Cornell.

Robert Mott-Smith will enter the shot put, discus throwing and the high jump. M. Lydgate will also enter the shot put and discus throwing. Between them they took first and second place in shot put in all the prep school meets. Mott-Smith has been taking second in high jump also.
