

SOCCER SCHEDULE PROVIDES FOR SIX TEAMS IN DOUBLE ROUND FOR SEASON

Palama Has Thirty Candidates For Association Team and Guardsmen Strong

Palama's success Sunday over the Waikikis has started a wave of enthusiasm for football that is not to be deterred by the closing of the Inter-collegiate season evidently. The Kalia squad had for long hesitated over entering the soccer association this season on account of a fancied shortage of men. At a meeting held yesterday, however, over thirty men volunteered for the club team to represent Palama in soccer this season. This assures the working out of the schedule for the association with six teams entered. Schofield has formally entered and the National Guard will spread itself with a first class team.

New Coaches

Jack Simpson, well known soccer player of this city, has volunteered to coach the Palamas and Alex Hickman, another star of the round football, has offered his services in like capacity for the Guardsmen. These appointments have been approved by the executive committee of the association and all is now ready for the banner season for the game.

The soccer season this year will open formally on January 8 and will carry on until March 13. Play has been arranged in two rounds.

In order to make the traveling of the Schofield team as light as possible it has been arranged that five games will be played at the inland post. In addition to this it is probable that a series of games between civilian teams will be staged at Schofield during the season for the edification of the service men.
