For several years it has been the custom for the Outrigger club to stage the open water swimming program, which includes races for men, women, boys and girls. The contests are held in the open water outside the reef off Waikiki beach, the contestants swimming along parallel to shore.

Arrangements have been made to have six events on the program. A large entry is expected in each event as many swimmers have already signed for various races. The purpose of the meet is to promote open water swimming and Outrigger club officials rely on the Thanksgiving Day races as the principal event of the year which tends to encourage and arouse interest in open water swimming.

This year the races will start promptly at 9 o'clock Thanksgiving morning, the races to be from the Public Baths and from Cunha's. The program includes the following events: Men's Castle swim; women's Public Bath swim; race for men over 30, Public Baths; race for boys under 18, Public Baths; race for boys under 16, Cunha's; girls' (noyice) race, Cunha's. Details of the contests are being taken care of by "Dad" Center.

Each year The Star-Bulletin presents a cup to the winner of the women's race, and the same offer has been made this year. In addition to The Star-Bulletin cup, a cup has been offered by Dawkins-Benny Co. for winner of the race for boys under 18 years of age.

Gold, silver and bronze medals have been ordered by the sponsors of the race and will be awarded to those placing in each event.
