

PLANS MADE FOR SURFBOARD RACE

Races Will Be Staged In Waikiki Canal On New Year's Day

Entry lists have been opened for the annual surfboard paddling races inaugurated last year by Dawkins-Benny Co., jewelers, which will be staged in Waikiki canal the morning of New Year's Day.

Entries may be filed with Cecil Benny, who is handling arrangements for the affair.

Last year the races were staged along Waikiki beach but it has been decided to hold them in the canal hereafter so that the course will be standard. It is also believed that more persons can watch the races if they are staged in the canal.

The competition this year will be open to all, whereas last year, it was limited to members of the Outrigger Canoe club. This move was made in order to stimulate interest in surfing and surfboard paddling and to bring out a large field of entries, Benny stated yesterday. Hui Nalu and Outrigger board stars will enter the races and unattached surfers have also announced their intentions of competing for the medals offered by the sponsors of the races.
