## Sickness Hits Kalihi Camp, Forcing Kalihi Six To Withdraw From Race

Manuel De Corte, official of the Kalihi Athletic club, announced this morning to The Star-Bulletin that the Kalihis have withdrawn from the A. A. U. Volleyball league now in progress.

Reason for the action was because of the lack of material due to illness. The Kalihi team was struck heavily when Alec Beck was ordered by the physicians to refrain from playing. Beck is the Kalihis' main slammer. Other illness and the breaking up of the well-developed combination makes Kalihis' entrance into the race inadvisable.

As the result of this move, only one game was played in the A. A. U. series last night at the Central "Y" court. Coach Wilder Parker's Palama Settlement sextette won from the Iwileis in three hard-fought sets.
